110 Rental Apartments for Seniors  
Completed 2004

Ednor Apartments at Stadium Place is the development of 110 affordable apartments for seniors at the former Memorial Stadium site. These apartments are part of the Stadium Place Retirement Community—one of Baltimore City’s newest communities for seniors 62 years and older. The newly constructed four-story building features two elevators, controlled access entry, community room with sunroom, on-site laundry facilities, activity room with a kitchen, lounge, computer center, hospitality suite, medical office suite and hair salon.

The 78 one-bedroom apartments range in size from 620 to 738 square feet and the 32 two-bedroom apartments range in size from 905 to 930 square feet. One unit is reserved for an on-site resident manager. These spacious floor plans include a living/dining area, a fully equipped kitchen, electric heating and air-conditioning, wall-to-wall carpeting, dishwasher, microwave, garbage disposal, and cable access. Many of the units have spectacular views of downtown Baltimore City. Eighteen of the apartments are fully handicapped accessible and four apartments are designed for the hearing and sight impaired.

Exterior campus amenities include “ThanksGiving Place,” a beautifully landscaped sacred space with a labyrinth and garden located at the entry plaza. The Weinberg YMCA, with fitness and aquatic centers and gymnasium, opened in late summer 2004. Additional supportive services are being offered to promote quality of life for the residents of Ednor Apartments at Stadium Place.
