Prior to that, Suzanne held the position of senior associate general counsel for The Rouse Company where she worked on the commercial real estate development of retail and mixed-use projects as well as urban centers and regional shopping centers across the country. She has also worked for the City of Baltimore's Department of Housing and Community Development.
