Rev. James serves on the clergy staff at the Cathedral of Grace St John AME Church in Aurora, Illinois and serves on several boards including Garrett Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston IL; Wheaton Bank and Trust, an affiliate of Wintrust Bank in Chicago; and Jackson Park Hospital & Medical Center on the south side of Chicago. Rev. Clark earned a Master of Divinity degree from Garrett Evangelical Theological Seminary, an MBA from Columbia University, a BS from New York University's Stern School of Business, and a Certificate from the Leadership Institute at Harvard Divinity School.
